The Tests of a Wise Person

James 3:13-18 *

A key to right talk is right thought. The tongue is contained in a cage of teeth and lips, but it still escapes. It is not intelligence that keeps the lock on that cage; it is wisdom— James now discusses the difference between true wisdom and false. When he speaks about wisdom, he is not thinking of how much *knowledge* a person has, but how he *lives* his life from day to day. It is not the possession of knowledge but the proper application of it that counts. We have here a portrait of the truly wise person and we have also a portrait of the worldly-wise person.

The problem: Are you a wise person? (3:13)

The portrait of a person exploiting worldly wisdom (3:14-16)

The portrait of a person exercising Heavenly wisdom (3:17-18)

Select verses on "Wisdom" in Proverbs

Prov 1:2	To know wisdom and instruction, To discern the sayings of understanding,
Prov 1:7	The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge; Fools despise <u>wisdom</u> and instruction.
Prov 2:2	Make your ear attentive to wisdom, Incline your heart to understanding;
Prov 2:6	For the LORD gives <u>wisdom</u> ; From His mouth <i>come</i> knowledge and understanding.
Prov 2:7	He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; <i>He is</i> a shield to those who walk in integrity,
Prov 2:10	For <u>wisdom</u> will enter your heart And knowledge will be pleasant to your soul;
Prov 3:13	How blessed is the man who finds \underline{wisdom} And the man who gains understanding.
Prov 4:11	I have directed you in the way of wisdom; I have led you in upright paths.
<u>Prov 8:11</u>	"For wisdom is better than jewels; And all desirable things cannot compare with her.
Prov 9:10	The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.
Prov 15:33	The fear of the LORD is the instruction for <u>wisdom</u> , And before honor <i>comes</i> humility.
Prov 16:16	How much better it is to get <u>wisdom</u> than gold! And to get understanding is to be chosen above silver.

Prov 17:24	Wisdom is in the presence of the one who has understanding, But the eyes of a fool are on the ends of the earth.
Prov 18:4	The words of a man's mouth are deep waters; The fountain of wisdom is a bubbling brook.
Prov 19:8	He who gets <u>wisdom</u> loves his own soul; He who keeps understanding will find good.
