Psalms 22, 23, 24*

“Remembering” is our focus this morning as we join together in the Lord’s Table. Just as all of us have memories of years gone by, each of us should remember the greater work of our Lord. Jesus instructs us to “remember Him.” Thankfully we are not left to our own fuzzy memory banks. God’s Word tells us very clearly *Who* we are to remember.

Psalms 22, 23, and 24 fit well together. Psalm 22 speaks of the Savior who suffered for us. Psalm 23 speaks of the Shepherd who guides us day by day. Psalm 24 speaks of the Sovereign Lord in glory. These psalms show us Jesus yesterday, today, and forever. In them we see the Cross, the Crook, and the Crown.
