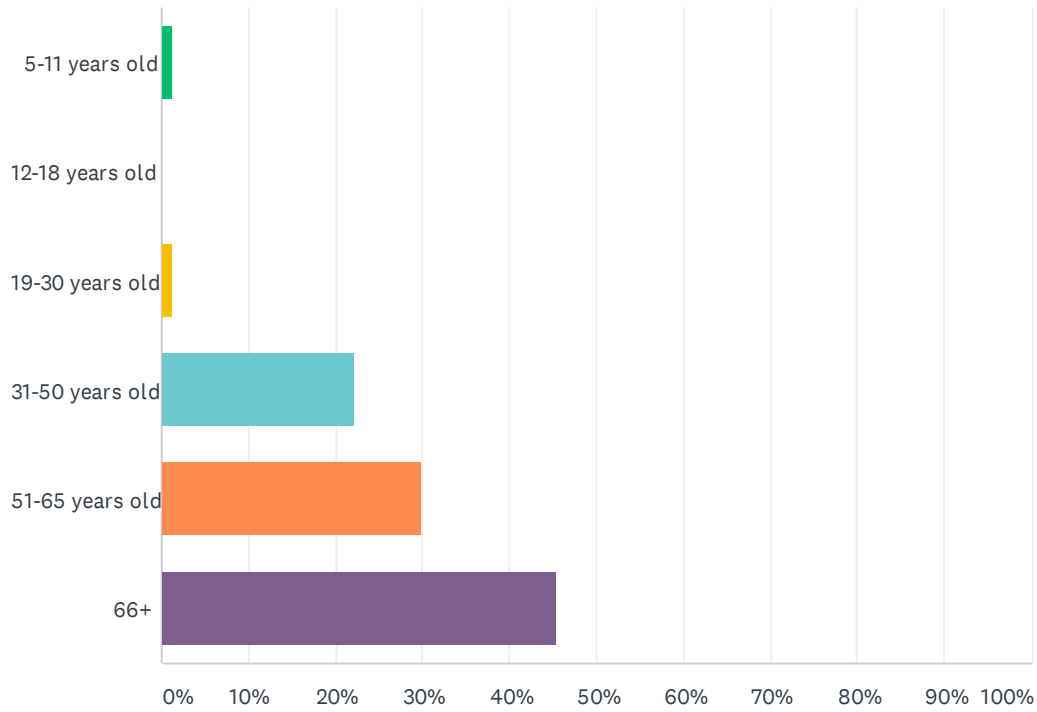

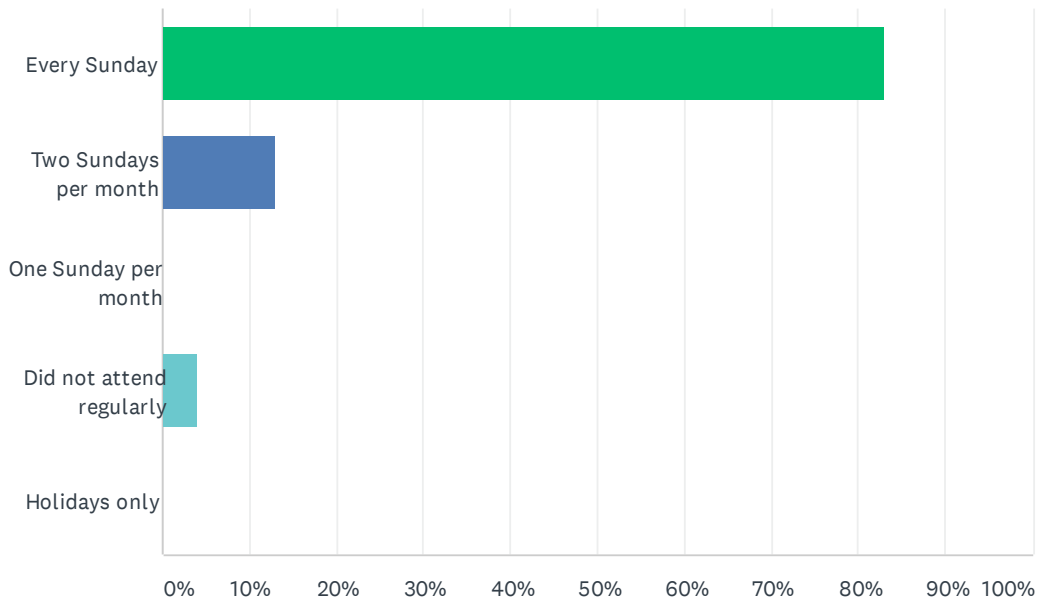

Q2 When GracePoint was meeting in our building, how often did you attend?

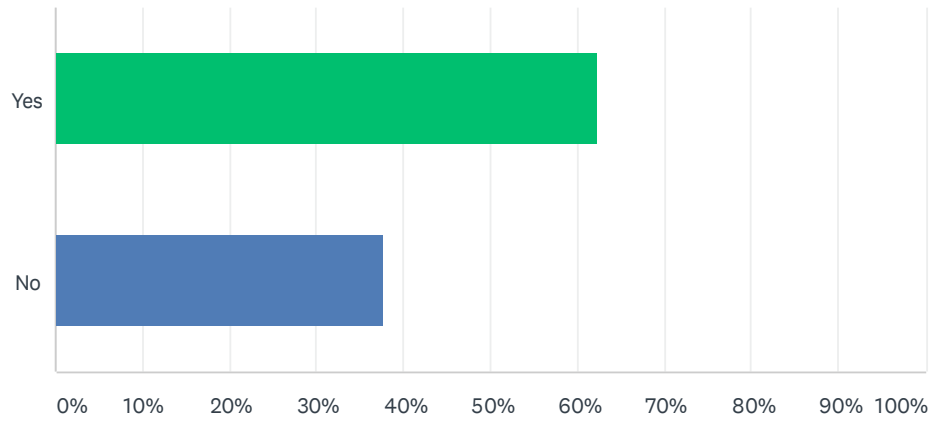

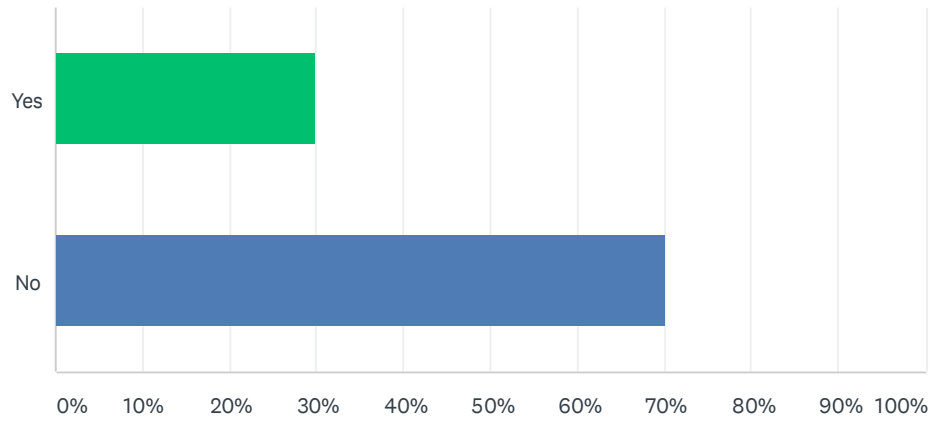

Q4 Do you use GracePoint's Facebook page?

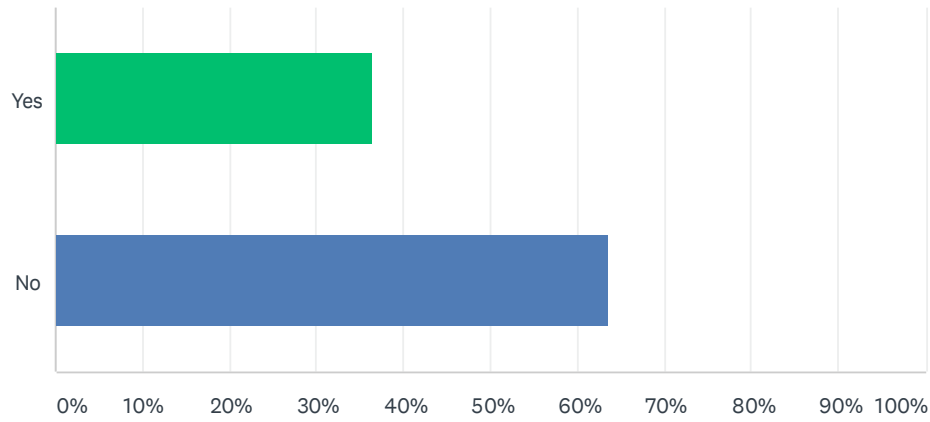

Q5 Do you use GracePoint's app?

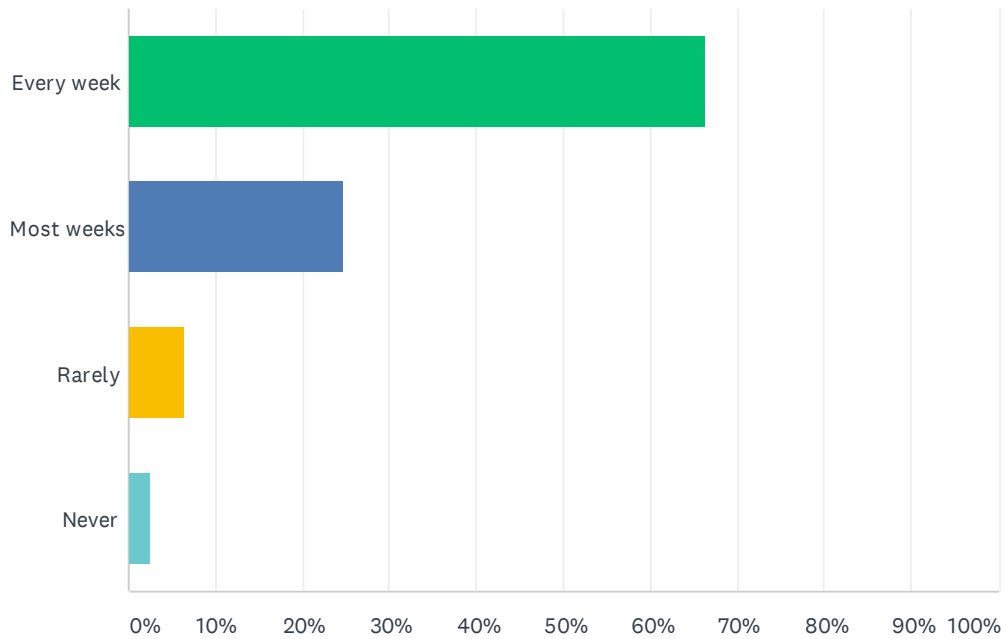

Q6 Do you view (listen to) the Sunday messages that are posted to GracePoint's website/Facebook/Youtube?

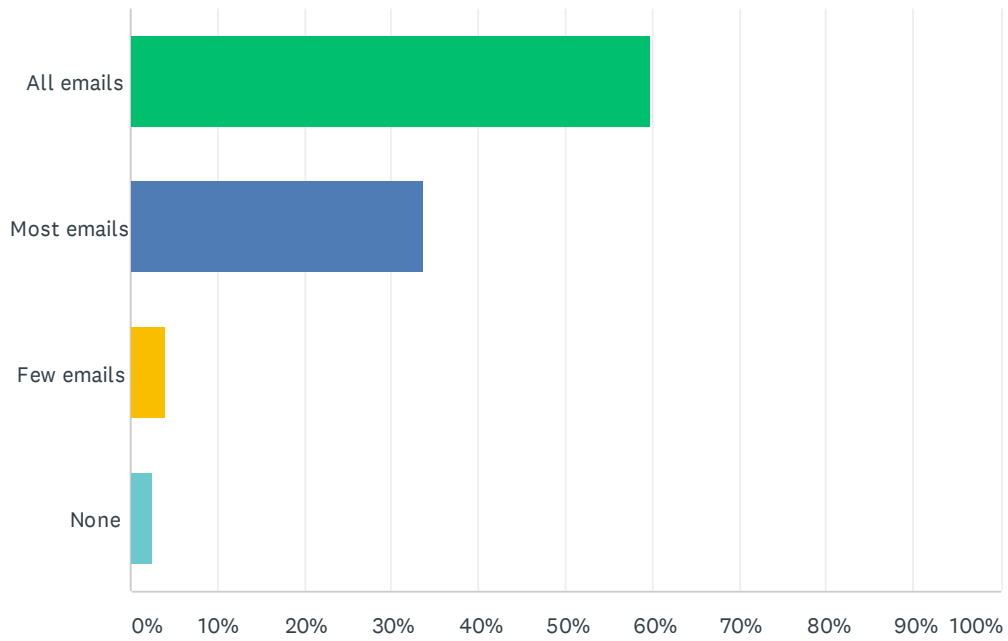

Q7 How many of the weekly emails from GracePoint have you read during this pandemic?

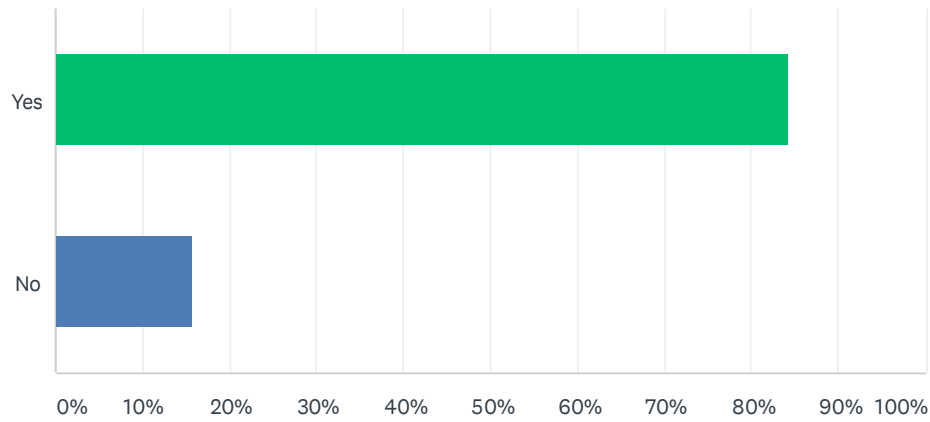

Q8 If there is not a Coronavirus vaccine, would you attend in-person worship gatherings?

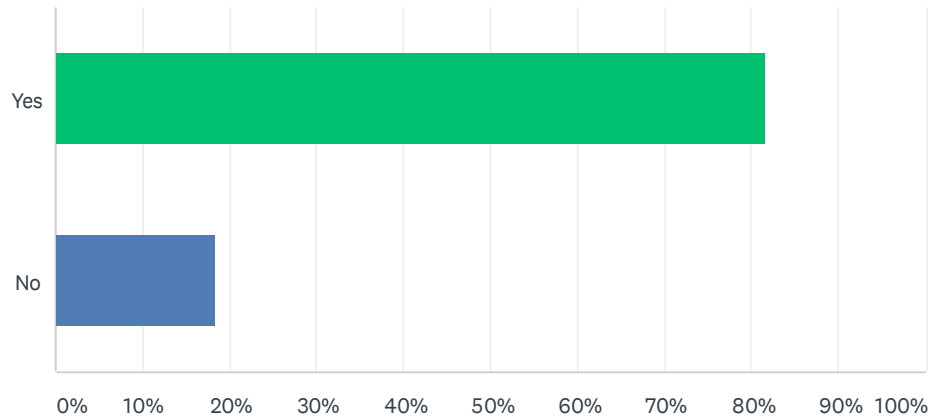

Q9 When we return to in-person gatherings, are you willing to wear a mask and maintain a 6-foot physical distance from others if recommended/required by the GCHD?

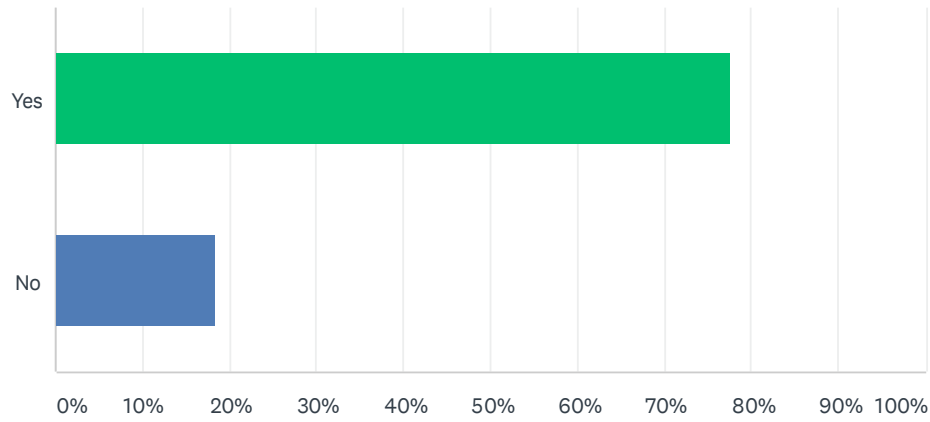

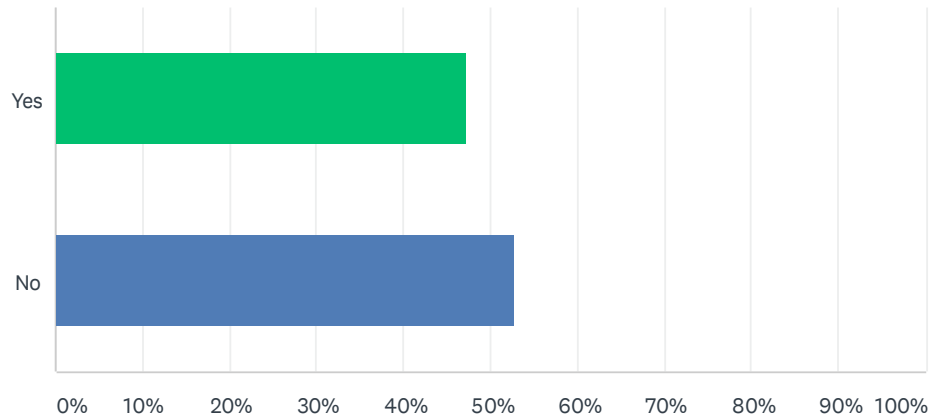

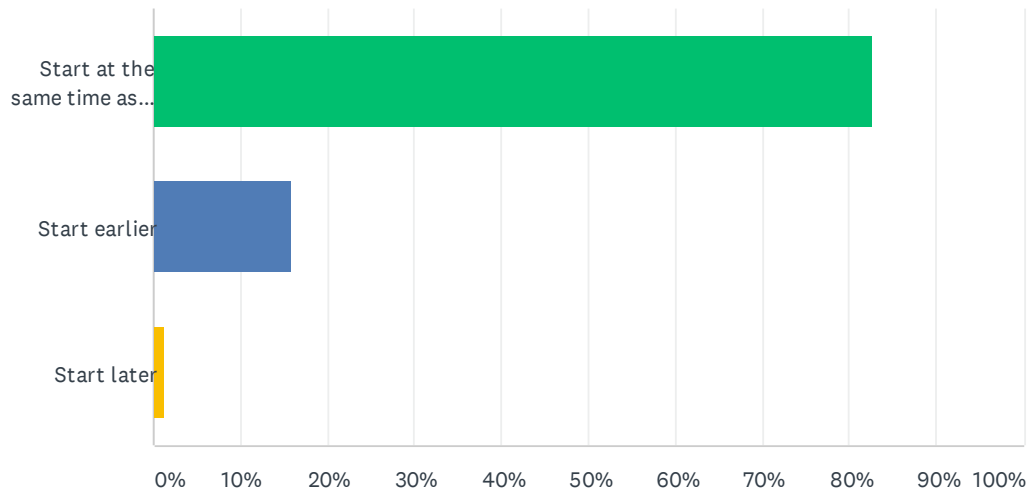
